



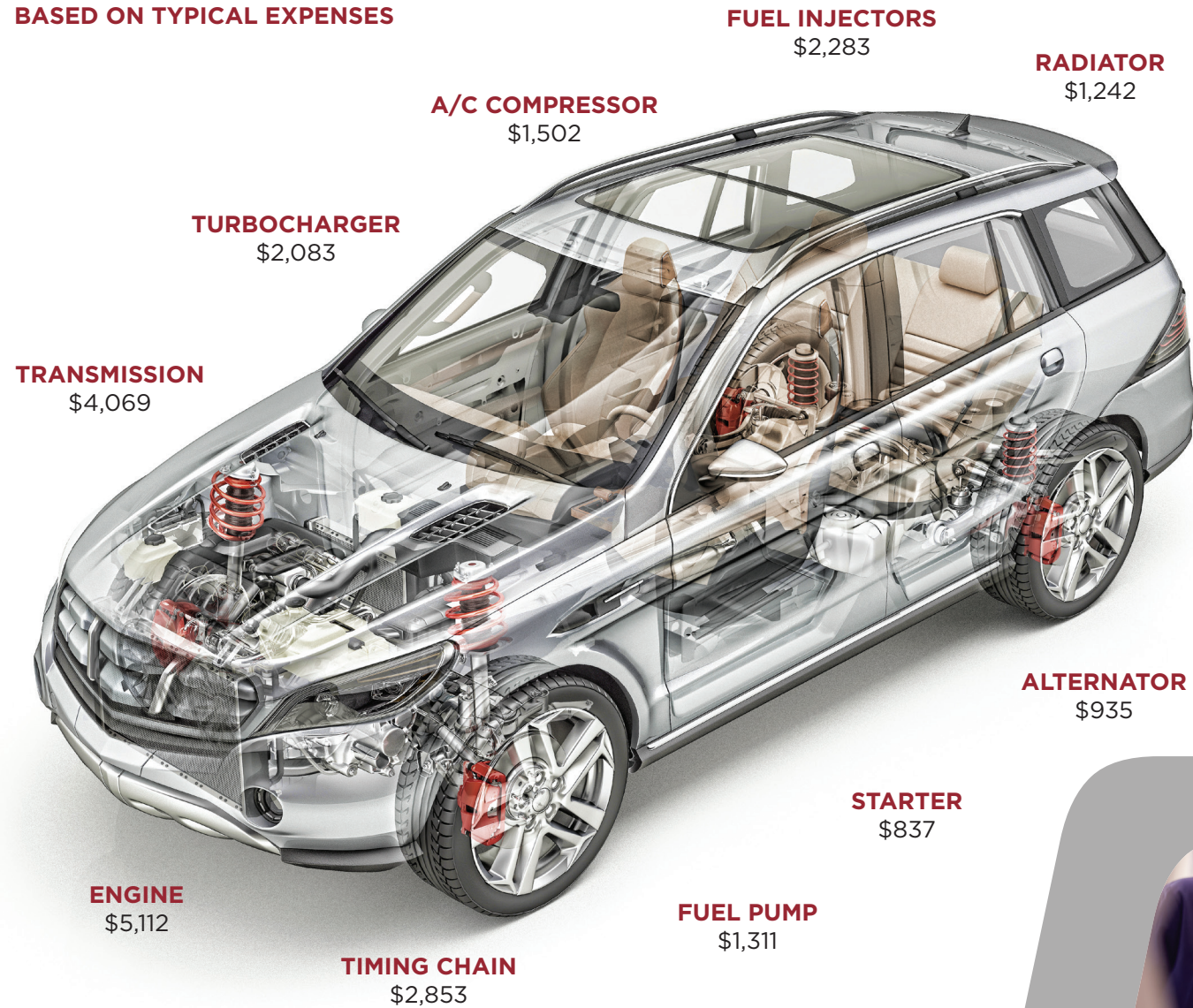

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT DOES A VEHICLE SERVICE CONTRACT DO FOR ME?

A vehicle service contract provides vehicle buyers with a safeguarding plan that delivers peace of mind, enhanced security, and financial savings. It alleviates concerns associated with purchasing a vehicle by assuring that a significant portion of repair expenses will be taken care of. This coverage substantially reduces the impact of unexpected repair costs, ultimately making vehicle ownership and maintenance more budget-friendly.

HOW DOES A PROTECTION PLAN WORK?

This plan offers support in the event of a covered mechanical breakdown or failure with your vehicle.
